

# Common graphs and charts

## Line graphs

Line graphs are a simple way to show different sets of relating data. They're easy to read so are great for putting into a presentation.



#### **Bar charts**

Another simple way of displaying data. It's usually best used for a single set of data and colour can be used to emphasise a key message.

### Scatterplot

Scatterplots are a good way to show a correlation between two data series. A line of best fit can be added to make the results even clearer.





## **Pie chart**

Pie charts are good for showing the breakdown of a few pieces of data. They can be impactful when used well, but be careful not to put too much data into them and to make the text clear.

# Area graphs

An area graph is similar to a line graph except it uses block shading to demonstrate the area or 'weight' of comparative pieces of data.
